On the back page you'll see a membership details form. Could you please let us know if any of your details have changed?

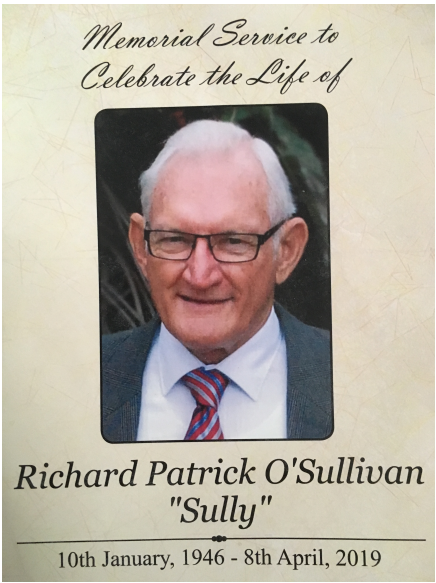
