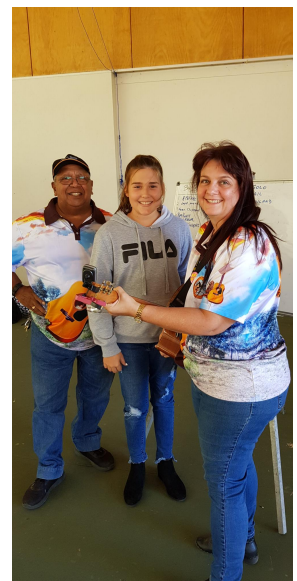


## SUNDAY FUNDAY 12<sup>TH</sup> MAY

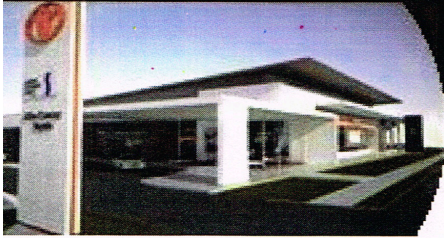
